
Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter No. K-12052-6/6/2017-LH dated 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 conveying Letter of Permission for admission to the First Year B.V.Sc & A.H. courses in the Apollo College of Veterinary Medicine, Jaipur, an affiliated college under RAJUVAS.

2. In the said letter at para (3), it was mentioned that the admission was for only First Year B.V.Sc & A.H. for the year academic year 2017-18 only instead of First and Second year.

3. The College requested that as per Rule 8(1) of the Veterinary Council of India (Procedure for recognition and de-recognition of Veterinary College and Veterinary Qualifications) Rules, 2017, the Letter of permission for admission to be issued for first and second year years. The request of the College was considered by the Advisory Committee and the Advisory Committee has recommended issuing the necessary correction allowing admission for the two years. The recommendation of the Advisory Committee has been accepted by the Competent Authority of the Central Government. Therefore the para (3) of the said letter may be read as " the Central Government has no objection to allow admission for first and second year...". However, the other terms and condition in the said letter will remain unchanged. This correction may be noted.
