Sir.

I am directed to refer to the letter number F(44)/RAJUVAS/Gen/2016/407 dated 12.07.2016 forwarding the application of requesting inspection of Apollo College of Veterinary Medicine, Jaipur for permitting admission for the academic year 2016-17. The Veterinary Council of India carried out inspection during 19-21 September, 2016 and forwarded the inspection report to the Central Government without any recommendation and the college could not take any admission during the year 2016-17. Apollo Animal Medical Group Trust has requested this Department to examine their application in terms of Veterinary Council of India (Procedure for Recognition and de-recognition of Veterinary Colleges and Veterinary Qualifications) Rules, 2017 and allow admission for the year 2017-18.

- 2. The Department vide letter No. K-12052-6/4/2016-LH dated has communicated the Letter of Inent with the condition that the college shall submit the Bank Gurranttee of Rs. 5.00 crores, application fee of Rs. 1.5 lakhs and furnish adequate documentary proof of having created a fixed deposit for a minimum duration of two years with a scheduled bank equal to the amount of estimated annual salaries payable to the faculty proposed to be employed by the Veterinary college during its second academic year as per the Rule 8(3). The aforementioned documents have been submitted by the College.
- 3. Therefore, the Central Government has no objection to allow the admission in the First Year B.V.Sc & A.H. for the academic session 2017-18 in the Apollo College of Veterinary Medicine, Jaipur subject to the condition that:
  - a) The College will submit the application in Form X at least one year prior to the scheduled commencement of its third academic year after complying with the requirements as per Rule 9 of Veterinary Council of India (Procedure for recognition and de-recognition of veterinary college and veterinary.
  - b) The Fixed deposit shall not be en-cashed without prior permission from the Central Government.
